Dear Parent,

As our Year 6 children start their final half term at St Vincent's we would like to inform you of a number of special events which have been arranged for them.

Firstly, we are taking Year 6 on a Geography field trip this term. We will be walking from school to Naden Brook and looking at aspects of this woodland environment.

The dates for these trips are:

- **Tuesday, 26th June:** for the children who are not attending the Bury Schools' transition day.
- **Tuesday, 3rd July:** for the children who are not attending Rochdale Schools' transition day and BRGS transition day.

The children do not need to wear school uniform for this trip. They will need suitable strong footwear and appropriate clothing for the weather, raincoats or (hopefully) sunhats.

Further dates for your information:

- **Tuesday 10th July:** Leavers' Mass at 6.30 p.m. in church. The children need to wear school uniform for this event.
- **Thursday, 12th July:** We will be performing our summer play for parents at 6:30 p.m. in the school hall. It is called "Keep Calm and Carry On" and the children will need to wear their evacuee outfits which they wore to the Stockport trip on the 5th July.
- **Monday, 16th July:** A Fun Day on the field (weather permitting) with barbecue and inflatable. This will be a non-uniform day for Year 6 and they will not need a packed lunch or dinner money.
- **Friday, 20th July:** Leavers' assembly for parents in the school hall at 9.30 a.m.
- **Friday, 20th July:** Leavers' lunch – the children will be invited to devise the menu for this day and will be able to sit with their special friend. If your child normally has packed lunches, they will be able to order a school meal for that day. School closes at 2.00 p.m.

We are sure these events will be memorable and enjoyable for the children. We wish them all the best as they move on to their High Schools.
